

LTTA in Romania

“Grigore Moisil” Theoretical High School hosted the second mobility of the Erasmus+ HiClass project (ID 2020-1-IT02-KA226-SCH-095699) from the 4th to the 8th of April 2022 în Timișoara. Our guests were students and teachers from our partner schools from Italy, Portugal and Macedonia. Here is the logbook of our activities:

April 4th, Monday

After the welcoming ceremony containing folk and traditional Romanian music performed by one of our students, a speech from our principal and a guided tour of our school, the students participated in ice breaking activities to get to know each other better.



Subsequently, students were introduced to the methodology of this mobility - creating mind maps with Google to extract the main ideas of a written text (on paper). This training together with the supporting text was provided by our English teacher Teodora Jurca. Students then created their first coggles and received feedback on them.

After lunch, we organized a visit at the library The Polytechnic University of Timisoara and a guided tour of the old city center for the participants in the mobility




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
April 5th, Tuesday

Tuesday began with sports games organized by a fellow member of the project, PE teacher Florin Belea, where students had the opportunity to develop coordination and relational skills in a competition style environment.



Students were then organized into seven teams and started creating their first coggles for the contest of the mobility, in the Humanities category, by having to extract the main ideas of a literary text.

made for team of coggles 4




In the afternoon the participants went on a visit with the tourist tram of Timisoara.



April 6th, Wednesday



On Wednesday morning the students and teachers took part in a building and flying kites workshop. Afterwards, the student groups worked on the second Coggle of the competition on a scientific topic. While the students were working, the teachers took part in a project meeting with the coordinator of the project participating online. In the afternoon, the participants took a tour on the vaporetto on the Bega river in Timișoara and in the evening, the teachers participating in the mobility had an official dinner with a traditional Romanian menu.



April 5th, Thursday



On Thursday, the final leg of the Mobility Competition took place on the current geopolitics topic: the war in Ukraine, based on two recent articles published in international journals. In the afternoon, the students took part in a paintball activity and all the participants enjoyed a barbecue prepared by our colleague, Florin Belea.



April 8th, Friday

The final day of the mobility was a celebratory occasion, as the winning team was presented their prize and all the participants received their mobility certificates. Moreover we organized a farewell multicultural party with karaoke for the participants (each partner chose songs from their home country to sing at the event).
