Do not see knowledge as a source of growth and pleasure

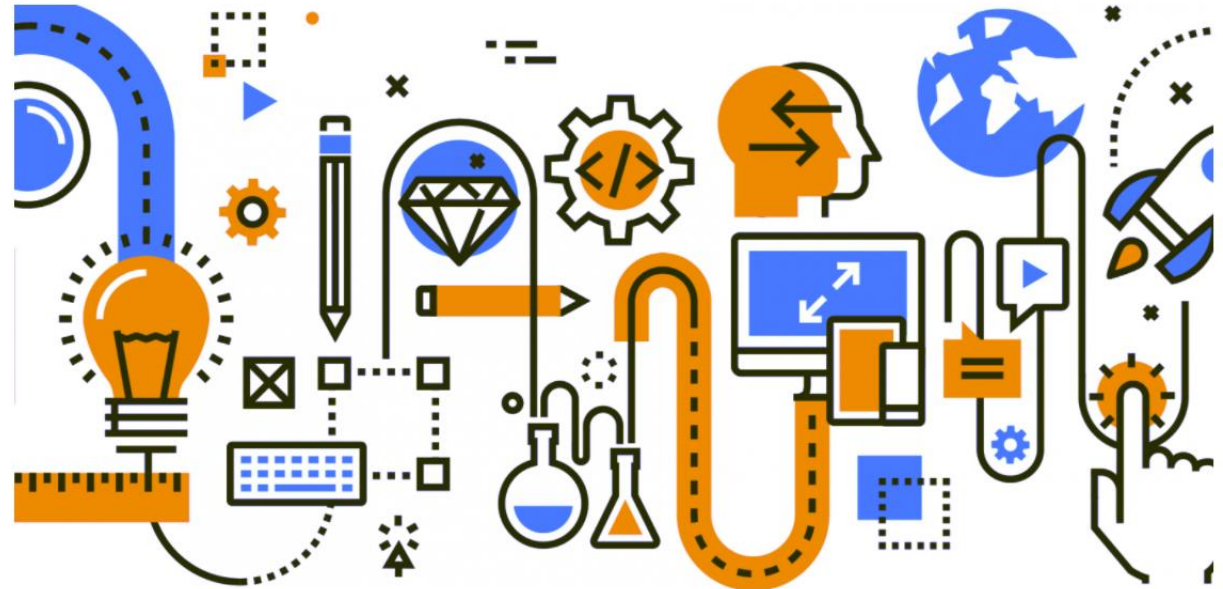
The partnership has the following objectives
